We will use three different zoom rooms for the NORMA20 conference: Zoom scientific, Zoom working group and Zoom social. Links to three rooms can be found on the programme page.

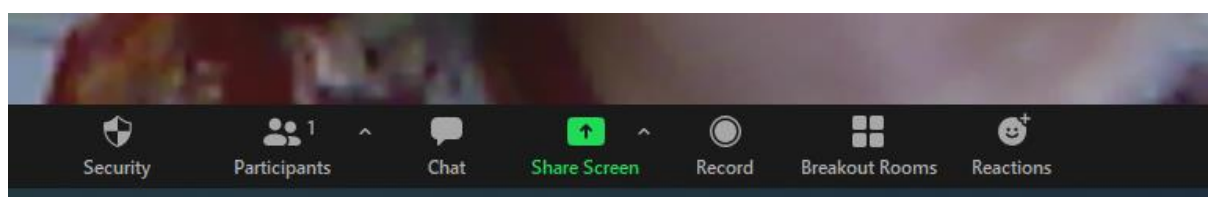
Zoom scientific

All plenary and parallel presentations will take place in Zoom scientific, with the exception of the working group session on Thursday. Please read the joining instructions for guidelines on how to present and to participate in discussions.

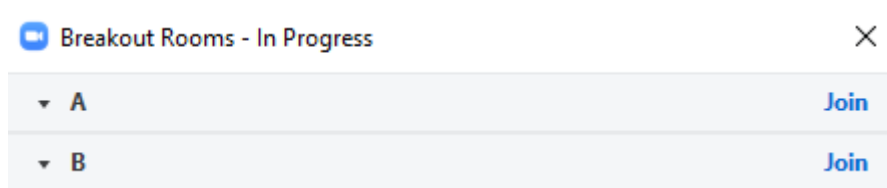
- Plenary lectures takes place in the main room. Your microphone will be muted when you enter. Please keep it muted at all times.
- Regular paper presentations take place in breakout rooms A - I. When you enter the main room, click breakout rooms in the bottom menu line and select the room you want to go to. Please check the programme page to identify which presentation you want to visit and which breakout room to go to. All papers labelled 1A, 2A etc. will be in room A. Papers labelled 1B, 2B etc. will be in room B.
- Short communication papers will take place in breakout rooms A – F. Each short communication presentation is allocated 20 minutes in total with 5 minutes break in between to change from one presenter to the next. You might choose to participate in three presentations in the same breakout room, or you might decide to move between rooms in the breaks and for instance visit paper 1A-1 and then go to 1B-2 before moving to 1E-3.
- Poster sessions will take place in breakout rooms A – C. The break between posters are short, merely 2 minutes. You can choose to listen to the three poster presentations in the same room, or you might move between rooms.
- The opening and closing will take place in the main room.
- The NoRME general assembly and the NOMAD presentation will take place in the main room.

Getting to the breakout rooms:

Hoover over the bottom of your zoom screen until you see this bar



Click Breakout rooms and select the room you want to go to, click join to enter the room.



To leave the breakout room, press leave room in bottom right hand corner (you need to hoover a little to see the leave button). Please do only press leave breakout room or you will exit zoom. When you leave the breakout room, you return to the main room and might select another breakout room.
