

Name	RAVEN`S PROGRESSIVE MATRICES CLINICAL EDITION (RAVEN`S 2)
Purpose:	Non-verbal test for the assessment of cognitive function in children and adults.
Short description:	<p>Raven`s 2 measures non-verbal intelligence or the ability to abstract reasoning. The child/adult has to find the system behind how different geometric figures are set up. Raven`s 2 represents an updated edition of Raven`s Progressive Matrices, and gather all previous versions inn one test. The updated version contains new tasks and norms. The test bank includes over 300 different tasks adapted to different age groups and achievement levels.</p> <p><u>Three versions:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Paper version: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 60 tasks divided in to 5 groups (A-E), with 12 tasks in each group. 2) Digital long form (Q-global): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 36 tasks for 4 – 8 years and 48 tasks for 9 - 69 years. 3) Digital short form (Q-global) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 24 tasks for all age groups.
