Purpose:	A Norwegian test of short-term memory and learning ability.
Short description:	Våletesten measures auditory-verbal short-term memory and portrays the children's learning curve for ten repetitions of words in relation to the mean and standardization of their grade. Våletesten is also a test of duration and concentration.
	Våletesten consists of twelve words divided in to three categories: Clothing, vehicles and animals. All the words are read aloud ten times. After each reading, the child's task is to remember as many words as possible.
Academic area/skills:	• Learning curve: Total number of words the child remembers after ten rounds.
	 Instant memory span: Total numbers of words after the first round. Learning phase: The shape of the learning curve after the first five rounds. Consolidation phase: The shape of the learning curve after the five last rounds. Total learning level: Total number of words the child remembers after all the twelve rounds. Learning strategies and systematics: How is the child's approach to the task, and does he/she become aware that the words can be grouped?
