<b>Name</b>	
<b>Purpose:</b>	Test for the assessment of cognitive abilities in young children
<b>Short description:</b>	The test is intended as a screening test for the most categories of difficulties in young children. However, the test has its clear limits for children with greater disabilities, for example, the practical / visual part is not suitable for individuals with major motor difficulties and the language part is not suitable for individuals with large language difficulties. Only parts of the test are relevant for the hearing impaired (the practical / visual part) and the visually impaired (the language part). The test is also of little relevance for more severe degrees of mental retardation, especially for the youngest children. The test is difficult to administer for children who are active and / or not motivated, partly because the material is not very motivating
