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| Purpose: | Frenchay dysarthria test is designed to assess speech motor skills in people with dysarthria (difficulty getting the speech organs (for example tongue) to perform the movements needed to pronounce particular language sounds) |
| Short description: | Frenchay dysarthria test is a Norwegian version of an original English test. The Norwegian version is the first and so far the only dysarthria test that is specially adapted for dysarthria patients with Norwegian as their native language |
