| Short description:                           | The Norwegian phoneme test is a language sound test that systematically assesses child's language sounds. The test identifies how consonants are pronounced in the middle and in the end of the words and how vowels and diphthongs such as ei, au and oi are pronounced. It can be used to evaluate children's vocabulary and to consider which measures should be implemented |
