

Parent's Evaluation of Aural/Oral Performance of Children and Ease of Listening (P.E.A.C.H +) v.4.1	
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Purpose:	To record how a child is hearing and communicating with others, as appropriate for their age
Short description:	P.E.A.C.H.+ is a validated questionnaire designed to record how a child aged under 5 years is hearing and communicating with others, as appropriate for their age. Parents/carers are asked to reflect on their child's listening behaviour in everyday life and give a rating for a selection of hearing and communication scenarios. Parents/carers think about their child's behaviour over the past week for each question.
