Purpose:	To uncover possible language difficulties and to evaluate the need for further investigation
Short description:	Language 6-16 is a screening test for language difficulties in children and adolescents from 6 to 16 years. The test is based on the fact that there is a connection between short-term language memory and an ability to form linguistic concepts. With the help of four sub-tests, one can distinguish between children with language difficulties and children without language difficulties across age levels and consider the need for further investigation
