

Name	GATES-MacGINITIE READING TEST (GMRT)
Purpose:	The Gates-MacGinitie Tests measure students' vocabulary and reading comprehension skills
Short description:	The Gates-MacGinitie Reading Test is offered at several different levels, which might be administered at the beginning and end of each school year. Level BR (Beginning Reading) and the 1 <sup>st</sup> grade measures comprehension of key language concepts and their ability to understand commonly used words. Test level 1 to 10/12 assesses reading comprehension and vocabulary skills for students in the 2nd to 12th grade
Academic area/skills:	To determine overall reading ability, specifically in the areas of decoding, phonemic awareness, phonics, vocabulary, and comprehension
Target group:	BR (Beginning Reading) and students in grades 1-12
Survey method:	Individually- or group-administered
Standardization:	American norms
