Purpose:	Assessment of reading and writing difficulties in adults, especially students
Short description:	<p>The tests are designed to identify dyslexia - or specific reading and writing difficulties. The test battery consists of a total of seven tests.</p> <p>Test 1 - Word chains Test 2 - Nonsense words Test 3 - Silent reading of text Test 4 - Word dictation Test 5 - Proofreading Test 6 - Reading aloud of words and nonsense words Test 7 - Reading aloud of text</p>
Academic area/skills:	Reading and writing difficulties
Target group:	The tests have been designed for students in higher education. Based on experience it is also possible to use the tests in relation to other groups of young people and adults, but one would not have a relevant norm basis
Survey method:	The tests are best suited for individual testing, but tests number 1-5 can also be used for group testing
Standardization:	The standards that are presented are based on tests at the Examen philosophicum, UiO. In total, approx. 300 students have been involved in testing of different versions of the tests. In addition, approx. 400 students participated in the standardization of the various tests. For tests number 1, 2 and 3, norms were collected from approx. 250 students in the fall of 1995. For tests number 4 and 5, norms were obtained from 156 students in the fall of 1996. For tests number 6 and 7, no norms were obtained. These two tests are included to provide opportunities for a more creative assessment of students' reading skills
