Purpose:	SSI-4 is used to accurately describe the stuttering behaviors of children/adults and to monitor treatment effects
Short description:	Stuttering Severity Instrument–Fourth Edition (SSI-4) is a reliable and valid norm-referenced stuttering assessment that can be used for both clinical and research purposes. It measures stuttering severity in both children and adults
Academic area/skills:	Measure stuttering severity in both children and adults in four areas of speech behavior: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •frequency •duration •physical concomitants •naturalness of the individual's speech
