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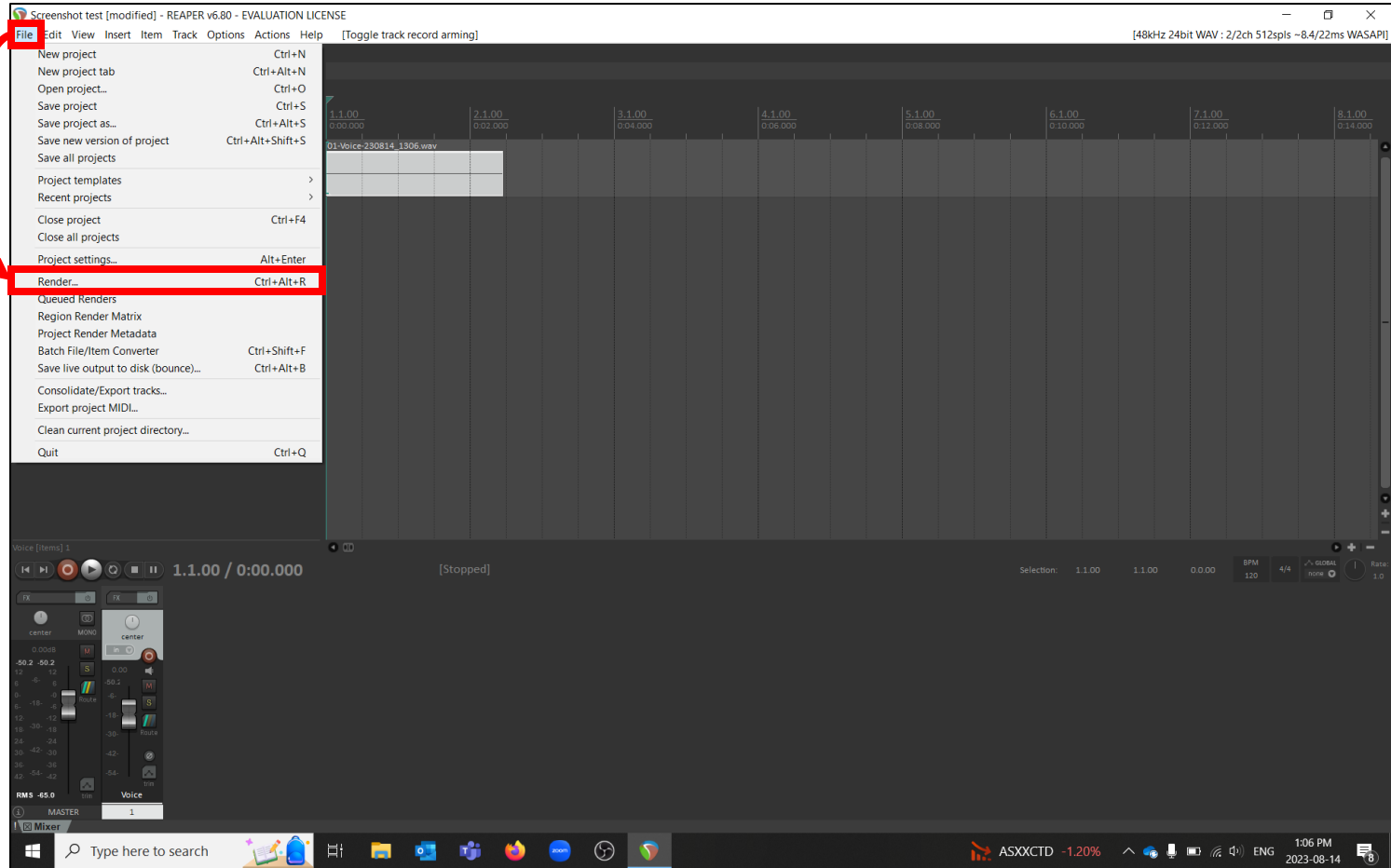

Exporting your podcast in Reaper | Windows

# STEP 1

1. Click **File** and select **Render**.

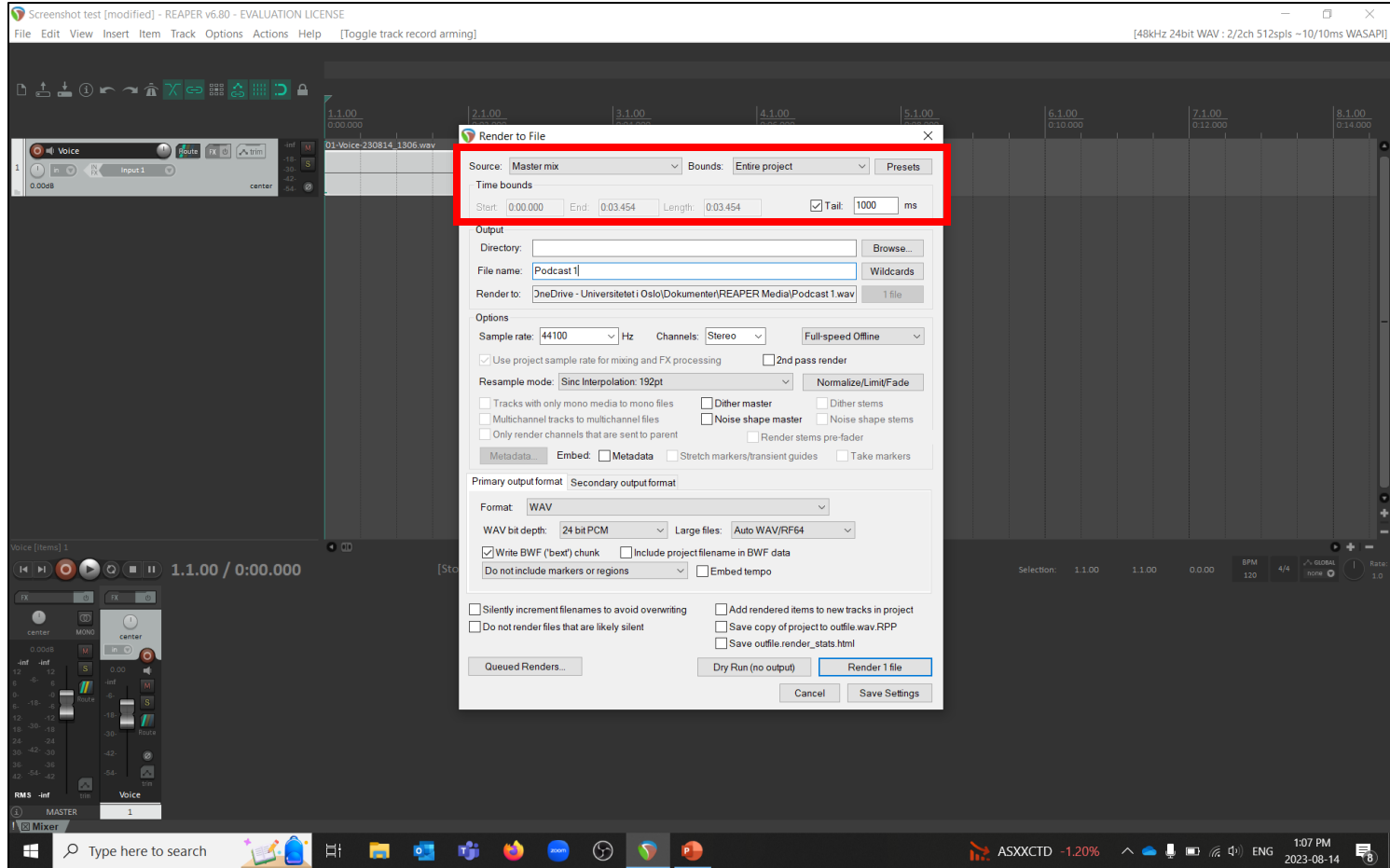
Or press **Ctrl+Alt+R**



# STEP 2

1. Ensure **Source** is set to *Master mix*

2. Ensure **Bounds** is set to *Entire project*

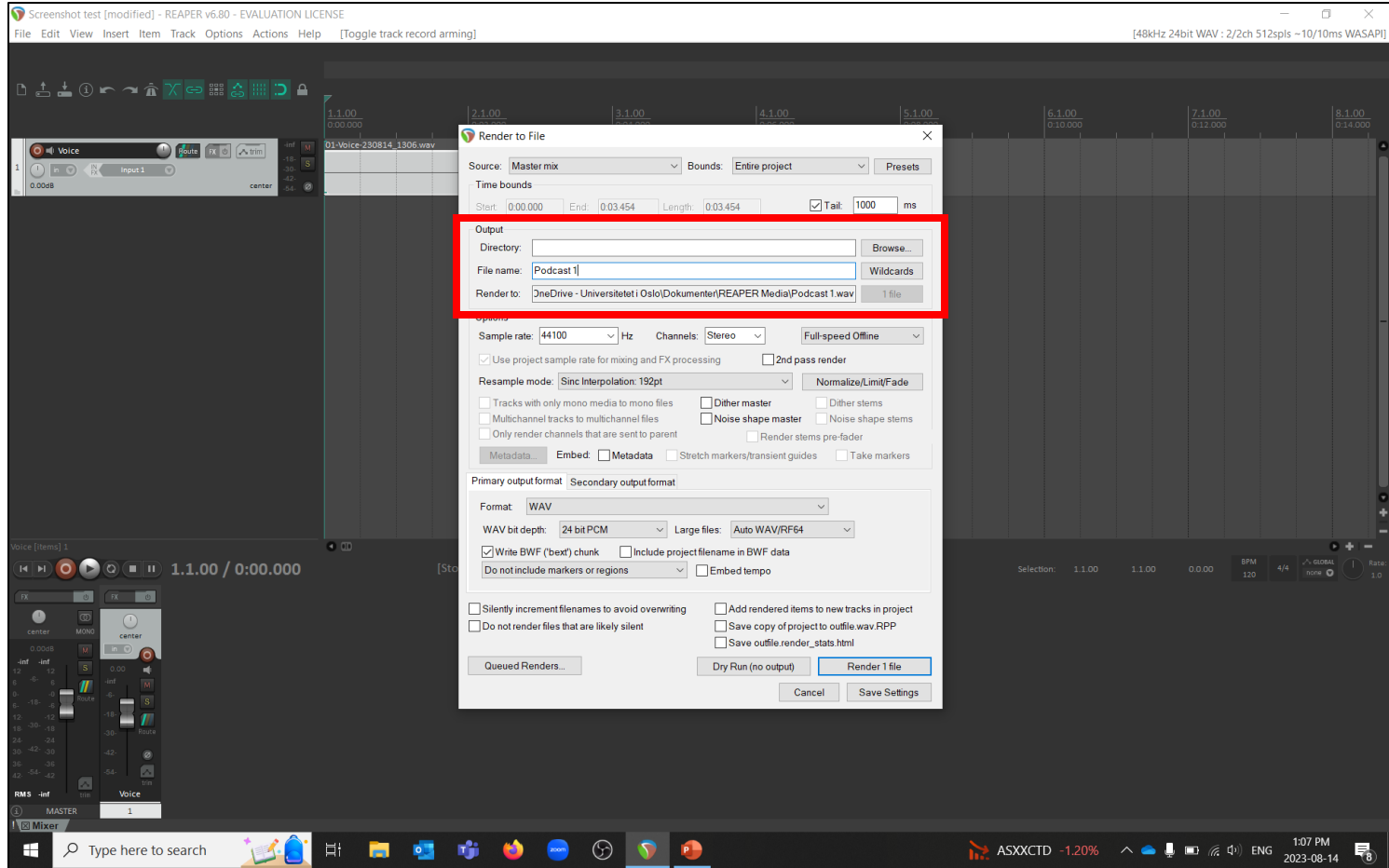


# STEP 3

Under **Output...**

**1. Directory:** This is your Save location. Use **Browse...** to set where you will save your podcast file to

**2. File name:** Type in a name for your podcast



# STEP 4

Under **Options...**

1. If your podcast is **AUDIO ONLY**, set the **Sample rate** to **44100**

If you will use your podcast with **VIDEO**, set the **Sample rate** to **48000**

2. Ensure **Channels** is set to **Stereo**

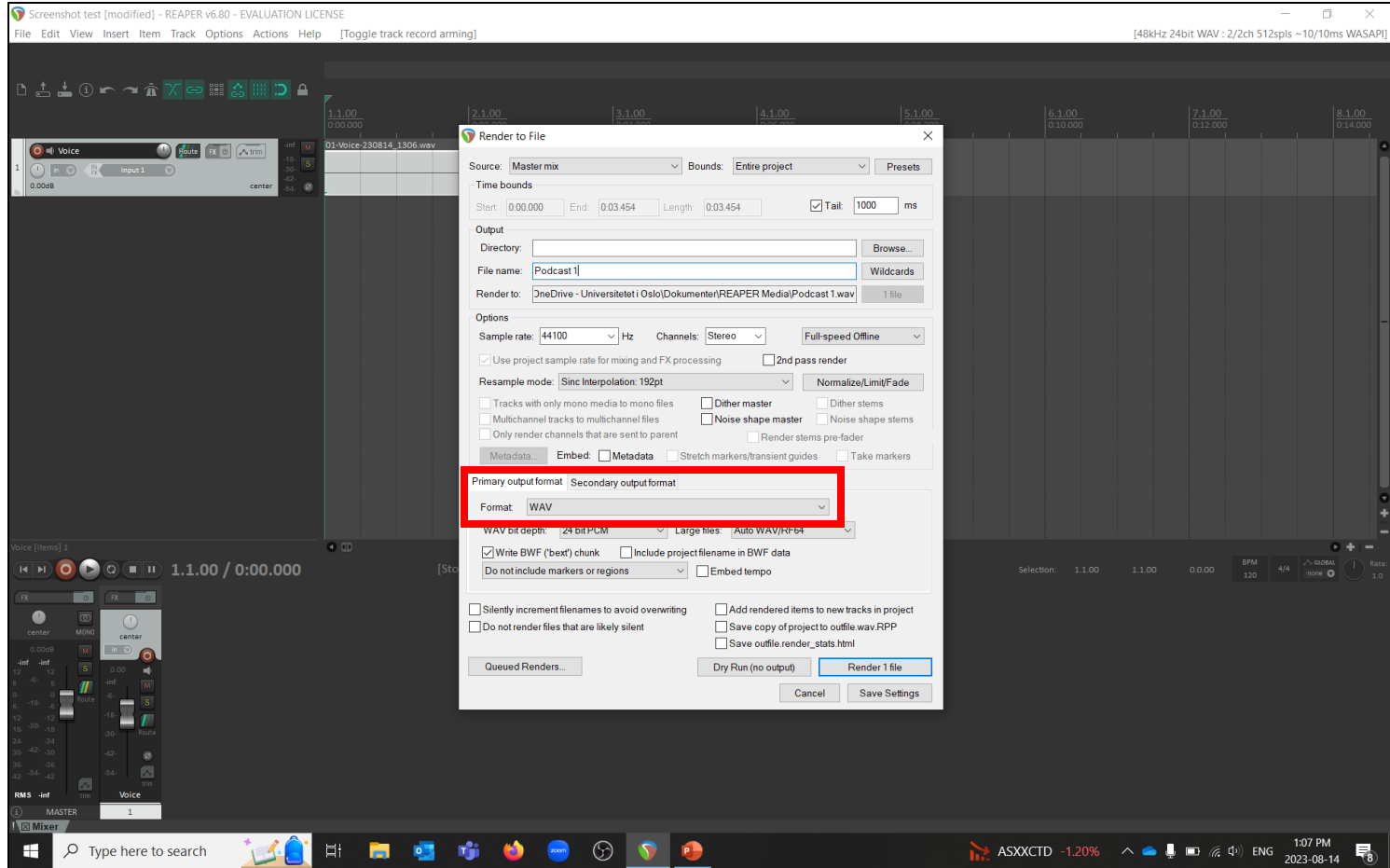
# STEP 5

Under **Format...**

**1. Choose WAV or MP3 (encoder by LAME project)** depending on your preference.

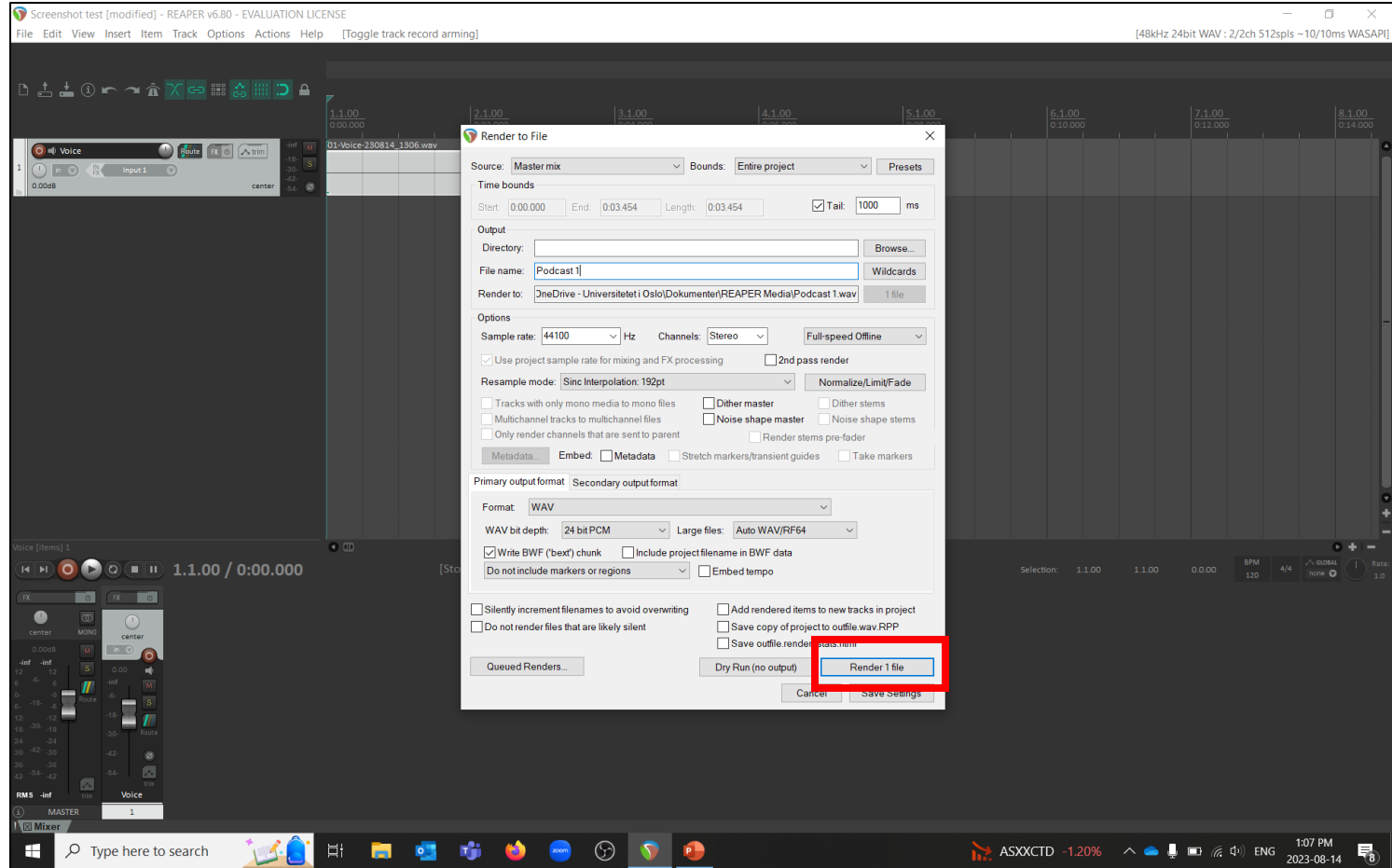
**WAVs** are larger files, with the highest quality audio

**MP3s** are smaller files, and maintain high quality audio.



# STEP 6

1. Click **Render 1 file**



# STEP 7

1. A new dialogue box will open as your podcast is exporting.
2. When the file export has finished, click **Close**
