Stroll around

Helsinki is famous for its architecture and there are many impressive buildings with interesting histories. Start by the Helsinki Railway Station and Walk along Mannerheiminkatu to Aleksanderin katu and be sure to see the Helsinki Cathedral at the Senate Square, the Uspenski Cathedral, and the Central Market? (Kauppatori) and have a coffee and a "lihis" (meat pie) at the Old Market Hall (Kauppahalli/Saluhallen).

Take a ferry trip

Take the ferry from the Central market (kauppatori) to the historical sight and old fortress on the island with the same name: Suomenlinna (Sveaborg). It was first constructed by the Swedes in 1748 as a defense against the Russians (it was originally called "Sveaborg" which means "Castle of the Swedes"). When the Russians took over Helsinki in 1808, they used it as a garrison. It was eventually taken over by Finland in 1918 and renamed Suomenlinna" (Castle of Finland). It's now a park and functioning residential area. It's also a UNESCO World Heritage site.
